Session Information

This lecture demonstration is designed to help studio teachers, instrumental teachers in schools and students understand the requirements of **VCE Solo Performance Units 1 – 4** and also to assist teachers to understand their responsibilities in the preparation of students enrolling in these studies.

Beginning with an overview of the study design, the focus will then move to the School Assessed Coursework (SACs) and the End of Year Practical Examination, and conclude with demonstrations of:

- Technical Work and Exercises (SAC) by students on a number of different instruments.
- Performances of selected works from the Set List of Prescribed Works
- Questions and discussion
